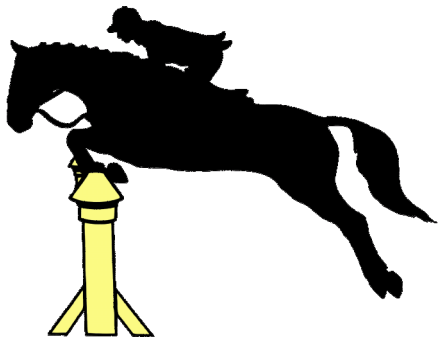


## RULES

- **Drive slowly** – remember this is our home and dogs, kids, horses and farm equipment also use the laneway
- **no smoking**
- **no dogs**
- approved helmets and riding boots must be worn
- put all money in deposit box. Do not give it to anyone else.
- do not feed horses without permission
- always use a halter and lead and remove it when putting a horse away
- take care of all tack you use and be sure it is put away clean
- no standing on gates and fences
- clean all messes you make and take your things home at end of lesson
- keep bathroom door closed when cold
- viewing area has a heater and we ask what you keep the door closed when heater is on – last person out must unplug heater

## Lessons

### LESSON TIMES

Lessons run Mon–Fri, 4:00-7:00 p.m

### LESSON PRICES

**There is one lesson per week and lessons must be paid in two month installments.**

**Beginner** – 1/2 hour group

\$33.00 per lesson

**Regular Lessons** – 1 hour group

\$43.00 per lesson

**Private** 1 hour \$63.00

**Semi Private** 1 hour \$52.00

**Private** 1/2hour \$46.00

**Semi Private** 1/2 hour \$41.00

All cheques are made payable to JANET OTT and are due the first week of September, November, January, March and May. July and August may be paid for monthly.

## CO-BOARDING

Available to any student that is ready. Cost is \$365/ month and includes two lessons per week. Students may ride 1/week plus their lesson. The barn closes at 9:00 p.m. every evening except Sunday at 6:00 p.m. The horse you co-board will be available for you to show. Students are asked not to jump and to stay in enclosed arenas only unless given permission to hack. No one else is to ride your co-boarded horse. All rules must be followed.

## BOARDING

Full board is \$460.00 per month (tax included). Full board at Ridgelawn is indoor board, and includes daily turnout. When moving your horse from Ridgelawn you are required to give a month notice before the 1st of the month that you will be leaving.



## SHOWING

Students will be able to participate in shows at Ridgelawn and away. All students may participate and spectators are welcome. Students must dress appropriately in show attire. Winter – any colour breeches and sweater, riding boots, helmet, gloves and a short jacket.

Summer – light colored breeches and shirt, show jacket, helmet, boots and gloves. All students showing must have a fitted white saddle pad.

### Costs:

- Horse rental \$30.00 -no horse rental for co-boarded horses
- Trailering—\$50.00 minimum per student and varies on distance
- Coaching  
Coaching fees at home \$40.00  
Coaching fees away \$55-75.00  
Payable to your coach
- Show Fees—Varies on the show

## COACHES

### Ashley Kostachen

Ashley got her start in riding here at Ridgelawn Equestrian. She campaigned in the jumper ring on the Future and A circuit for several years before switching to dressage. There she won many FEI junior classes and competed for three years on the young rider's dressage team. After selling her young riders horse "Big Tyme", she made the switch back to the jumper ring. Currently, she is training young horses and instructing at Ridgelawn Equestrian. She is competing on her jumpers "Mr. Klean" and "Rolling Thunder" as well as "Suzie" in the Lows on the A circuit. She has students competing at the schooling and trillium levels and A's.

### Jackie Fulton

Jackie has been competing and training over the past 25 years. She has competed successfully on the Trillium and A Circuit in the hunters and the jumpers. Jackie spent 8 years in Australia riding jumpers. She was a member of the Tasmanian Show jumping committee where she organized shows, instructed numerous clinics, judged and competed at the Hobart Royal on her two young jumpers.

Returning to Ontario in 2000, she started teaching, training as well as organizing shows for Ridgelawn Equestrian. Jackie is currently showing on the A circuit jumpers "Mr. Klean" and "Rolling Thunder". She has some students competing at the schooling, Trillium and A circuit levels.
